Applications for the Plasterers' and Cement Masons' Apprenticeship Programs will be available as follows;

**MONDAY, TUESDAY, and WEDNESDAY** of each week between the hours of 8:30 am to 11:30 am until further notice.

Applications will be taken at Northwest Ohio Construction Education Center, 4535 Hill Avenue, Toledo, Ohio 43615.

Applicants must be **18 years or older**, must present a **valid State issued ID** for the state in which they reside, must be a **high school graduate** (or graduating within the current semester with a letter from high school administrator verifying applicant's current progress will result in graduation) or possess a **General Education Diploma (GED)**. If applicant does not possess a GED, they will be allowed to continue the application process, but if accepted into the program, they must be enrolled in an accredited GED program, approved by the JATC, within the probationary period of the apprenticeship program or they will be terminated from the apprenticeship program. **Transcripts and/or GED with test scores** must be submitted with the completed application. Applicants must be **physically capable** of performing all phases of the trade without posing a direct threat to the health and safety of the individual or others. Applicant must successfully **pass a drug screen**. Applicant must successfully **pass an aptitude test**. Failure to comply with any of these requirements will result in automatic disqualification.

The recruitment, selection, employment, and training of apprentices shall be conducted without discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin, age, or sex. The sponsor shall take affirmative action to provide equal opportunity in its apprenticeship program as required under Title 29 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 30; Ohio Administrative Code 5101:11; and the equal employment opportunity regulations of the State of Ohio.
